Enrico David (born 1966, Ancona, Italy) was nominated for the Turner Prize in 2009. Institutional solo exhibitions have been held at Castello di Rivoli, Turin (2025), which will travel to Kunsthaus Zürich, opening in February 2027; KW Institute for Contemporary Art, Berlin (2023); Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, Washington, D.C. (2019); Museum of Contemporary Art, Chicago (2018); Sharjah Art Foundation, Sharjah, UAE (2016); The Hepworth Wakefield (2015); UCLA Hammer Museum, Los Angeles (2013); New Museum, New York (2011); Fondazione Bevilacqua La Masa, Venice (2011); Museum für Gegenwartskunst, Basel (2009); Seattle Art Museum (2008); and ICA London (2007). In 2019, David was included in *Neither Nor: The Challenge to the Labyrinth* at the Italian Pavilion, Venice Biennale. He lives and works in London and Turin.

A talk between Enrico David and Massimiliano Gioni, Artistic Director of the New Museum, New York will take place at the gallery on Friday 15 May at 5:30PM.
